Momordica charantia Long, thick bitter melon with rounded bumps and classic bitter flavor. 2.

MITSUBA, KANSAIKEI

Cryptotaenia japonica Three-leaved Japanese herb. This Kansai type is used for its aromatic dark green leaves. 3.

RED & GREEN SHISO

Perilla frutescens var. crispa Strong plants with highly fragrant serrated leaves. Varieties of Perilla.

VARIETY NOTES

CHIVES, SUPER NEW BELT AKA Nira, Garlic Chives. Perennial with abundant flat leaves.

SPONGE GOURD SHORT Luffa gourd. Easy to grow in warm climates.

HOJISO PERILLA A type of Shiso produced for the purple/white flowers.

OHBA SHISO PERILLA Flat-leaf Shiso common in Japanese cuisine.

KINGOMA SESAME Golden sesame. 85 days to harvest. Mild, nutty flavor.

KUROGOMA SESAME Black sesame. Need warm weather and well-drained soil.

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
